Only consistently profitable companies can afford to keep paying dividends, so profitability is of critical importance. And investors shouldn't pay too expensive a price to buy a stock, even if the company itself is strong. So therefore, dividend investors should be most interested in researching the strongest most profitable companies, that also happen to be trading at an attractive valuation.

Each month, Dividend Channel screens through our coverage universe of dividend paying stocks, to look at a variety of data – dividend history & yield, book value, quarterly earnings – and compare it to the stock's trading data to come up with certain calculations about profitability and about the stock's valuation (whether we think it looks "cheap" or "expensive"). Our proprietary DividendRank formula ranks stocks within the following 18 sectors/categories, to identify the top most "interesting" ideas that merit further research.

DHT Holdings is engaged in operating a fleet of crude oil tankers. As of Mar. 16, 2016, Co.'s fleet consisted of 20 crude oil tankers of which all are wholly-owned by Co. The fleet in operation consists of 17 very large crude carriers, which are tankers ranging in size from 200,000 to 320,000 deadweight tons, one Suezmax tanker, which ranges in size from 130,000 to 170,000 dwt and two Aframax tankers, which are tankers ranging in size from 80,000 to 120,000 dwt. Co.'s fleet principally operates on international routes and its fleet in operation had a combined carrying capacity of 5,656,937 dwt.

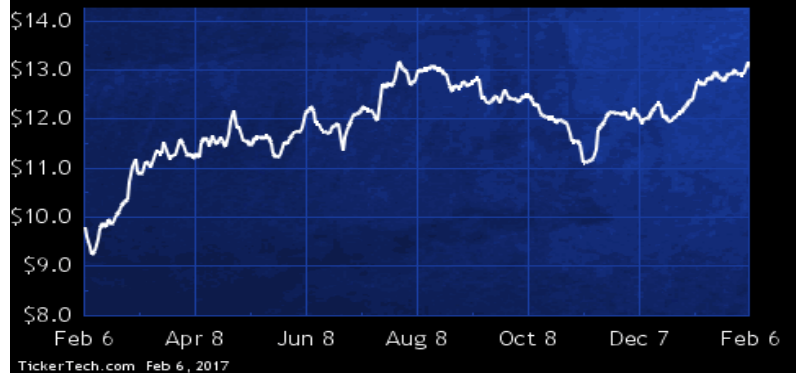

Utility-grade wood pellets are used as a substitute for coal in both dedicated and co-fired power generation and combined heat and power plants. Co. loads the finished wood pellets into railcars, trucks and barges that are transported to deep-water marine terminals, where they are received, stored and loaded onto oceangoing vessels for transport to its customers.
